Purpose and Mission

We are providing this Bible School for young people who are serious about their walk with God. We intend to provide an atmosphere of spirituality and discourage worldliness and carnality. We are not expecting everyone to be at the same place in their walk with Christ. However, we do expect students to be willing to be taught and guided in their walk with Him.

Our mission and purpose is threefold:

- ◆ To give the youth a week of concentrated Bible teaching
- ◆ To stimulate them to a closer walk with Christ and a deeper commitment to Him
- ◆ To provide an opportunity for them to fellowship with other like-minded youth

The schedule is full of teaching, prayer, sharing, and singing. There will be a revival service every evening except Wednesday and Saturday. The students will be supervised throughout each day and evening. Our church families will be providing lodging for the youth. If you have a dedicated young person in your home, they are welcome to send in an application. We will evaluate the application, and if accepted, respond with a confirmation as soon as we can. If it is not accepted we will send an explanation as well.

Among other things, we will ask the students to respect the following guidelines:

- ◆ No students may leave the premises without permission from one of the principals.
- ◆ Students will be expected to attend all sessions.
- ◆ Modest attire is required. We ask that the young ladies do not wear slacks, do not have slits in their skirts, and are double covered (jumper, cape dress, or something similar). We also ask that the young men do not wear T-shirts or blue jeans.
- ◆ We ask that the young ladies wear their hair up, and prefer that they wear a head covering.
