PURPOSE AND MISSION

The purpose and mission of this Bible School is to provide teaching and instruction in a controlled environment to those young people who are serious about their relationship with Christ. We desire to provide an atmosphere with the least amount of distractions possible for the learning and growth of each student. We don't expect every student to have the same relationship or experience with Christ. However, we do expect each student to be willing to learn and to be compliant to the standards of the Bible School.

We will evaluate each application and send a confirmation if accepted, and if not accepted, we will send an explanation.

Registration for the students will begin at 8:00 AM Monday morning.

The schedule is full of teaching, prayer, sharing, and singing. We will have a revival service each evening except Wednesday and Saturday evening. Sunday evening will be a program with the student chorus singing.

The students will be supervised throughout each day and evening. The local church families will provide lodging for all the students.

In an effort to provide the best atmosphere for growth, development and learning we have a few guidelines we feel are pertinent to mention in this application:

1. No student may leave the premises without permission from a principal except in the evening to return to your host family.
2. Students will be expected to attend all sessions.
3. Modest attire is required that conceals the form of the body. Thus modesty without question is the expression.

a. Young Ladies:

We ask that the young ladies wear a dress or skirt without slits and a loose-fitting second layer (jumper, cape dress, vest, or something similar). We also ask that the young ladies wear their hair up and prefer they wear a head covering.

b. Young Men:

We ask that the young men do not wear T-shirts, blue jeans or any other comparable casual clothing.

4. We request that you do not use cell phones on the school grounds, except in an emergency. If you need to make a call during school hours, please obtain permission from a principal or a matron. This would include texting and any other social media activity.
5. The Bible School will plan no other extracurricular activities and we encourage students to not engage in activities that would be a distraction from the purpose of Bible School.

6. If a principal or matron made a request of you, how would you respond? (It would, of course, need to comply with Bible School standards.)
7. Do you have any suggestions for subjects that you would like to have taught at Bible School?

It also indicates that you are willing to be under the authority of and take direction from the administrators, principals and matrons during the week of the Bible School.
