PURPOSE AND MISSION

The purpose and mission of this Bible School is to provide teaching and instruction in a controlled environment to those young people who are serious about their relationship with Christ. We desire to provide an atmosphere with the least amount of distractions possible for the learning and growth of each student. We don't expect every student to have the same relationship or experience with Christ. However, we do expect each student to be willing to learn and to be compliant to the standards of the Bible School.

We will evaluate each application and send a confirmation if accepted, and if not accepted, we will send an explanation.

Registration for the students will begin at 8:00 AM Monday morning.

The schedule is full of teaching, prayer, sharing, and singing. We will have a revival service each evening except Wednesday and Saturday evening. Sunday evening will be a program with the student chorus singing.

The students will be supervised throughout each day and evening. The local church families will provide lodging for all the students.

In an effort to provide the best atmosphere for growth, development and learning we have a few guidelines we feel are pertinent to mention in this application:

1. No student may leave the premises without permission from a principal except in the evening to return to your host family.
2. Students will be expected to attend all sessions.
3. Modest attire is required that conceals the form of the body. Thus modesty without question is the expression.
 - a. Young Ladies:
We ask that the young ladies wear skirts or dresses without slits and be double covered (jumper, cape dress, vest, or something similar). We also ask that the young ladies wear their hair up and prefer they wear a head covering.
 - b. Young Men:
We ask that the young men do not wear T-shirts, blue jeans or any other comparable casual clothing.
4. We desire that you do not use cell phones on the school grounds, except in an emergency. If you need to make a call during school hours, please obtain permission from a principal. This would include texting and any other social media activity.
5. The Bible School will plan no other extracurricular activities and we encourage students to not engage in activities that would be a distraction from the purpose of Bible School.

2017 QUESTIONNAIRE

All students are required to complete this section.

In our application, we explain that this Bible School is open to those individuals who are serious about their walk with God. Following are questions we would like you to answer on a separate page as part of this application. This information will be kept confidential to the Bible School Administration.

1. Have you been born again into the kingdom of God? Please explain your answer.
2. In that you are filling out this application, it is understood that you are serious about your walk with God. We would like to understand clearly how that affects your life and character. Please write a description of your life and character.
3. In an effort to get to know you a little better, following is a questionnaire we would like you to complete.
 - A. Do you listen to Contemporary Christian Music? Country music? Rock music? Hymns? Other types of music? Please explain why and how much of your time you spend listening to each.
 - B. How much of your time do you spend listening to the radio, or other types of audio? Please explain what you listen to and why.
 - C. How much of your time is spent watching movies, YouTube videos or any other videos for entertainment?
 - D. How much of your time is spent on social media: i.e. Facebook, Google plus, Instagram, Twitter, texting and other similar types of electronic communication?
 - E. How much of your time is spent reading the Bible or other Christian books?
 - F. How much of your time is spent playing electronic games?
 - G. Do you have a personal cell phone? Is it a smart phone?
 - H. Do you have a personal computer? (i.e. laptop, tablet, phablet, etc.)
